## Code of conduct for the guests of holiday park Het Timmerholt.

You are very welcome at our great holiday park and in the beautiful province of Drenthe.

Behave responsibly, which is appreciated by your fellow guests, local residents and employees of Timmerholt! Together we make sure you can continue to recreate!'

Get off the site or park and go out! Get some fresh air, exercise and enjoy nature. In this day and age, let's work together to make sure it stays safe and possible.

Compliance with the rules of 'the code of conduct for guests of campsites, group accommodations and other holiday parks' contributes to this!

## All the time...

- Always keep 1.5 meters distance from each other, give each other space !
- Do not go out with more than the maximum number of people allowed at that time.
- Avoid social contacts.
- If you cough, have a cold or have a family member's fever, stay at home!
- Avoid crowds in nature and other areas, stay different in or near your holiday home.
- On the holiday accommodations that are affiliated with HISWA-RECRON a corona protocol applies. Take note of it and strictly follow the regulations.

• As a destination, avoid busy places and busy times. Your host can inform you about this. Good preparation

• Check the website of your park where you are staying and of the municipality for up-todate information about special measures - such as closure of areas, paths and roads and parking spaces - and guidelines.

• Use cycling and walking apps so you can accurately plan your route.

• Catering establishments are currently closed. Therefore, on a longer trip, bring food and drinks for the road. From 28 April, the terraces in Midden Drenthe will also be open to you again, subject to conditions. Enjoy the weather on the way!

• Do not stand unnecessarily still and ensure a smooth passage. Prevent group formation at all times.

• Take into account fences or one-way traffic in places where it is (otherwise) not possible to keep 1.5 meters distance from each other, such as watchtowers and narrow paths.

• Always be careful! Be careful with risky maneuvers, do not needlessly endanger yourself and others.
